

Certificate of Non-Credit Terminal Operating System Software Training

The Non-credit Terminal Operating System Software Training Certificate provides participants with advanced knowledge of NAVIS N4 and XPS software, a digital platform used at the Port of Virginia. Participants will have an overview of NAVIS N4 and XPS systems; and learn, analyze and solve problems related to container search and filter, container storage, cargo transport and movement, equipment control, and more.

Content Description

Hands-on instructor-led training on how to use terminal operating system software to manage cargo movement through a container terminal. The first two modules offered in July 2019 are listed below:
