#### REQUIREMENTS

To be accepted into the Teacher Education Program, a student must:

- Be a declared major in the appropriate academic department
- Have a 2.75 grade point average overall, in the major, and in the professional education core courses (2.80 for IDS majors beginning with the 2004-2006 University catalog)
- Earn at least a C- grade in all courses in the major and in the professional education core (C grade in all courses for IDS majors beginning with 2004-2006 University catalog)
- Have passing scores on Praxis Core or achieved approved scores by the Virginia Board of Education
- Submit the Undergraduate Teacher Education Application (after passing Praxis and achieving 2.75 GPA)
- Submit the Admission Interview Application if required for your program as specified.
