- 5. Did the speaker demonstrate any vocal deficiencies that we have explored? If so, what stood out to you?
- 6. Do you feel that the speaker practiced thoroughly for her or his presentation?
- 7. Did the speaker demonstrate good inflection and proper pronunciation?
- 8. Did the speaker appear conversational and natural?
- 9. Was the speaker's voice loud and clear enough to hear?
- 10. Please provide an overall assessment of the presentation. Were you satisfied with it? Why or why not?
