Section of the Design Standards Being Considered:

C3.13 Public Restrooms. Paragraph n.

- i. Soap Dispenser: The University desires to use hands free soap dispensers for each sink, but this is not always the case. The placement of these dispensers should be carefully considered to avoid mounting the dispenser on mirrors. Confirm with the university the current soap dispenser being used.
- ii. Toilet Paper Dispenser: Provide the following toilet paper dispenser in all locations. Confirm with the University the current toilet paper dispenser.

Von Drehle model 31002a – 1b JRT toilet paper dispenser (large roll), for non-ADA locations the recommended mounting height is 24" to bottom of unit.

Brief Description of the Current Requirement: The above description was based on the vendor under contract at the time of the standards development. These have changed as reflected below.

Suggested Wording for the Proposed Change:

- i. Soap Dispenser: The University desires to use hands free soap dispensers for each sink, but this is not always the case. The placement of these dispensers should be carefully considered to avoid mounting the dispenser on mirrors. - ii. Toilet Paper Dispenser: Provide the following toilet paper dispenser in all locations. Confirm with the University the current toilet paper dispenser. [The current dispenser is:](#)

– JOFEL 310 – 02PLVON (Altera 12" JET) Dispenser, for non-ADA locations the recommended mounting height is 24" to bottom of unit.
