- ITN 101 and ITP 150 will be used to fulfill CYSE 250 requirement at ODU.
- CYSE 200T, CYSE 300, 3 credits of Cyber Principles and 3 credits of Cyber Applications are met by completion of AAS with Cybersecurity track and grade of C or higher in the designated courses.
- These courses can be taken at ODU or GCC. If taken at GCC, student must choose courses from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> 9 credits in any of the following categories: Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature, Interpreting the Past or Foreign Language; and 8 credits in the category of Nature of Science. Remaining lower-division general education requirements are met by completion of all courses outlined in this transfer agreement guide.

Notes (continued):

- Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU, students must notify academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.
- Students with successful completion of selected industry certifications will receive CYSE 3ELE (3 credits per certificate, up to 6 credits maximum).
