- If AAS requires any other courses (i.e. CST 100, SOC 215, HLT 230, CST 229, MTH 154 or ITE 119 or 152) please request substitution approval at the community college or complete ENG 112 and MTH 155/245 as additional courses at CC or ODU. Refer to note 3.
- These courses can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, student must choose courses from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> 12 credits in any of the following categories: Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature, Interpreting the Past or Foreign Language; and 4 credits of Nature of Science. Remaining lower-division general education are met by completion of all courses outlined in this transfer agreement guide. If student doesn't take any of the PHI courses listed in the agreement, PHIL 345E will have to be completed at ODU.
- Take whichever course (s) you did not take as General Education Elective (s) when completing AAS: ENGL 211C (ENG 112) and STAT 130M (MTH 155/245) are both required for BSPH (6 credits).

Notes (continued):

- *Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU, students must notify academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.*
- *To qualify for the BSPH, Health Services Administration Professional major at Old Dominion University through the articulation agreement, students must qualify through licensure or certification and employment experience.*
- *Students must complete major declaration requirements listed in the University Catalog before officially declaring the Health Services Administration Professional major. Students who have met all major declaration requirements will be referred by their advisor in the Health Sciences Advising Center/ODU Online Health Sciences advisor to the program director for major declaration, program admission and assignment to a program advisor.
