- Approval in June 2025

# **Legislative Priorities**

- Requested:
  - o \$16.5 Mil in operating support/base funding
  - Engineering &Arts building pre-planning funding secured, \$300Mil project
  - Renovation of Spong and OEAS requested

#### **Compensation Study**

- Phase 1 implementation in July
- Total 4-5 phases will be required

#### **IT Updates**

Website migration to Drupal:

- Started in Fall 2022, supposed to be done in a year, was extended to Summer 2024. Many pages have broken links because they were created by different users and stored on different servers. ODU has acquired a software that will be searching and repairing broken links and will prevent new from being created.

#### Banner Migration to Cloud:

• Issues due to very outdated version of Banner and many homegrown systems linked to it over the years.

Identified problems should be reported to Provost Payne.

#### AI work

• University is moving forward with undergraduate AI certificates, faculty fellowships, new hires – Centennial Cluster Initiative.

#### VHS@ODU

• Minor issues encountered post-integration that were expected

#### New ODU Org Structure

- 2,200 full-time employees and 22,700 students
- Before we had 7VPs now it's 11VPs
- UVA has 20 VPs, VT has 19 VPs

#### **Changes in communication**

• President is changing the monthly meetings with the Senate Executive Committee to once per semester. Will also meet with the full Senate once per semester.

#### **General Discussion;**

- Maintenance funds needed for buildings BAL elevator is not working for months, another one gets stuck – the work is in place for replacing all 3 elevators
- Uni needs more in base-operating funds from the state to address maintenance
- All issues Senate EC needs to communicated with the Deans -- > Provost --> VPs--> President
- Tenure-track for Lecturer not on President's radar. Provost would support the conversion to TT process rather than tenure-track for NTT.
- Compensation study identifies percentiles: Phase 1 will address who's below that for compensation.
- Provost office is looking for consistency in compensation for noncredit courses
- Overloads come from the college budget not central budget (like adjuncts) because of the traditional practices
- VP of Marketing Osborne will meet with the college liaisons to update website issues and faculty photos
- Research Foundation added more people from EVMS after integration, VP Fridley wants to come and talk to Senate. EC will discuss the possibility of January back-up meeting for this visit.

- What are the boundaries of ODU campus that determine crime reports? ODU currently does not recognize any fraternity/sorority houses. It will be included in the Master Plan.
- Students prefer on-line courses when they have both options. 1% of students switch from in-person to all online mode.
- Shortage of faculty and adjuncts to cover students demands in World Languages & Cultures Department
- Engineering student prefer hybrid classes.
- Administration needs to show what faculty investments were done. University gave \$2.375min to AA: 1/3 will go to AI faculty initiative; not clear where the rest of this will go but potentially to faculty investment.
