- 2. If you complete MTH 155 or 245 with a grade of C or higher instead of MTH 154 at NVCC, student will not have to take STAT 130M at ODU.
- 3. CRJS 262 plus CRJS 2ELE (6 credits) will be awarded for Police Academy training if applicable.
- 4. These courses can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, student must choose courses from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <a href="http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html">http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html</a> 3 credits in any of the following categories: Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature, Interpreting the Past or Foreign Language; 8 credits in the category of Nature of Science; and 3 credits in Human Behavior (Do not take a course equivalent to PSYC 2015, SOC 2015 or CRIS 2155 because these are already fulfilled within the AAS requirements). Remaining lower-division general education requirements are met by completion of all courses outlined in this transfer agreement guide.

- > Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU, students must notify academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.
- Course requirements listed in this agreement are based on the 2022-2023 catalogs for each institution but are valid until 2024, unless an updated agreement guide was created and is available on the ODU Transfer Pathways website: https://odu.edu/transfer/transfer-pathways/vccs
- > Grade of C or higher is required to receive course credit.
