

Choose a course from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> in the following categories: 3 credits in Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature or Foreign Language; and 3 credits in the category of Human Behavior. Please consult with your VPCC advisor to select the appropriate course.
3. MFET 320 and MFET 235 will be used to fulfill 6 of 9 MET Senior elective credits.
4. Course can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, choose one course from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> in the following categories: 3 credits in Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature, Interpreting the Past or Foreign Language. *These courses are beyond the completion of the AAS degree.

- Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU, students must notify academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.
- Course requirements listed in this agreement are based on the 2024-2025 catalogs for each institution but are valid until 2027, unless an updated agreement guide was created and is available on the ODU Transfer Pathways website: <https://odu.edu/transfer/transfer-pathways/vccs>.
- Grade of C or higher is required to receive course credit.
