I have only two updates for you today.

1. The new Biological Sciences building project will begin with demolition probably in April or May of 2025. This is approximately a 6 month delay. Pile driving will be in the summer. We will monitor the issue of noise during final exams as the schedule comes more clearly into focus.
2. Weeds and bushes have been removed from around the pond near OCNPS/PSB. This is unrelated to the new Biology building project. The plan is to landscape the shoreline and add shrubs to improve the look back to the original design.
