1. Request substitution at CC to take ITE 119 instead of ITE 115 to fulfill STEM 251G requirement for BS degree.
2. BS degree requires MTH 154, 155, 161, 162, 167, 245, or 261; if MTH 130 and BUS 125 is taken, student will have to take the required 3 credit Math course at ODU.
3. Choose courses from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> in the following categories: 3 credits in Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature or Foreign Language; and 3 credits in Interpreting the Past (History). Also ensuring these courses fulfill the electives required for the AAS.
4. BUS 200, BUS 205, MKT 100 and ECO 201 will be used to fulfill MGMT 325, MGMT 340, MKTG 311 and ECON 200S requirements for BS degree.
5. These courses can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, choose one course from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html>: 8 credits in the category of Nature of Science; and 3 in Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Interpreting the Past, Literature, or Foreign Language. Remaining lower-division general education requirements are met by completion of all courses outlined in this transfer agreement guide.

Notes (continued):

- Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU, students must notify academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.
- Course requirements listed in this agreement are based on the 2021-2022 catalogs for each institution but are valid until 2024, unless an updated agreement guide was created and is available on the ODU Transfer Pathways website: <https://odu.edu/transfer/transfer-pathways/vccs>.
- Grade of C or higher is required to receive course credit.
