- Choose courses from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> in the following categories: 3 credits in Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature or Foreign Language; and 6 credits in Interpreting the Past (History). Also ensuring these courses fulfill the electives required for the AAS.
- For this agreement only, IND 121 will be used to fulfill MGMT 325 and IND 150 will be used to fulfill MGMT 340 requirements for BS degree.
- Requires completion in one of the following ways:

a) 3+ years of a Registered Apprenticeship, as documented by the US DOL and/or the VA DOLI, and approved by TCC and ODU. Registered apprenticeship must include a minimum of 6000 clock hours of on-the-job training and 432 clock hours of classroom instruction.

b) Significant and documented training and work experience, approved by TCC and ODU.

A maximum of 24 credits applicable to the degree may be awarded following successful completion. Students needing additional courses to reach the 24 credit hours required in content skills and knowledge will select courses in collaboration with the academic dean (or designee) to meet student and/or employer needs. Upon transfer to ODU, student records will be evaluated to meet the following requirements: MET 120, STEM 221, STEM 231, STEM 241, STEM 242, STEM 321, STEM 351, and/or STEM 382.

- These courses can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, choose one course from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html>: 8 credits in the category of Nature of Science; and 3 in Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Interpreting the Past, Literature, or Foreign Language. Remaining lower-division general education requirements are met by completion of all courses outlined in this transfer agreement guide.

Notes (continued):

- Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU, students must notify academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.
- Course requirements listed in this agreement are based on the 2021-2022 catalogs for each institution but are valid until 2024, unless an updated agreement guide was created and is available on the ODU Transfer Pathways website: <https://odu.edu/transfer/transfer-pathways/vccs>.
- Grade of C or higher is required to receive course credit.
