2. Student must choose a course from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> in the category of Literature, ensuring it also meets the 200-level elective required for the AAS; 3 credits in Human Behavior (excluding SOC 201S, PSYC 201S and CRJS 215S which are already included in the AAS), also ensuring it meets the Social Science elective required for the AAS; and 4 credits of Nature of Science category, also ensuring it meets the approved Science elective required for the AAS.
3. These courses can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, student must choose courses from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> 3 credits in any of the following categories: Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature, Interpreting the Past or Foreign Language; and 4 credits in the category of Nature of Science.
