- I. Office of University Advancement Mr. Brandon presented and discussed dashboard items measuring productivity in the area of Development which included fundraising amounts for total giving, planned giving, annual funds, college giving and donor counts.
- II. Old Dominion Athletic Foundation Mr. Justin Jannuzzi, Director of Old Dominion Athletic Foundation (ODAF), reviewed the new ODAF brochure which has been a key marketing and communication piece for the upcoming football reseating process. The ODAF staff has worked tirelessly to ensure alumni, donors and friends of the university are informed of the reseating process through individual appointments, town hall meetings, reminder phone calls and use of the new ODAF website. Football reseating will take place May 14 31 and parking requests will be taken thru June 15.
- III. Office of Alumni Relations Ms. Dana Allen, Assistant Vice President for Alumni Relations reviewed data trends of email communications to alumni along with an overview of marketing and communication tools. Alumni have an email open rate of 17% for registered alumni and 7% for non-registered alumni. Ms. Allen reviewed the recent successful alumni activities as well as upcoming alumni events and focus areas.
