## <u>APPOINTMENT OF HEAD FOOTBALL COACH</u> <u>INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS</u>

RESOLVED, that upon the recommendation of President John R. Broderick, the Board of Visitors approves the appointment of Mr. Ricky Rahne as Head Football Coach, effective December 10, 2019.

Mr. Rahne received a Bachelor's degree in Industrial and Labor Relations from Cornell University in 2002. Mr. Rahne has served on the Penn State University football coaching staff for the past six seasons, starting as quarterbacks coach and moving into other roles including passing game coordinator, tight ends coach, and eventually was promoted to offensive coordinator. While Mr. Rahne was calling the plays, the Penn State offense was particularly productive this past season and was ranked 16<sup>th</sup> in the nation in red zone touchdowns and averaged 204.9 yards rushing per game, its best mark in 10 years. Penn State earned bowl bids in all six years that Rahne served the Nittany Lions. Prior to his time at Penn State, Rahne was an assistant coach for Vanderbilt University for three seasons. He also coached for five seasons on the Kansas State University staff and spent one season each as an assistant coach at College of the Holy Cross and Cornell.
